Nip Tuck?

One of most impressive face-lifts I've seen all year is the incredible transformation of the Grand
Dame of the Strip: Caesar's Palace. If you haven't been there in a while you won't believe how well the
improvements have gone – everything from the splendid facility for Celine and Elton and the many new and superb
restaurants; to the expansion of slot space. It flows well, has good game variety, and one of my favorite little cocktail venues – The
Seahorse Lounge – that not only has great architecture and superb people-watching, but comes with a 15-foot circular aquarium
filled with – what else? – sea horses! Classy and classic, Caesar's proves you can upgrade and modernize your facility without
losing your traditional brand identity.

Need to do a Report for the Home Office?

One major development on the Strip is the new Las Vegas Monorail connecting the MGM all the way to the Sahara, with a convenient stop at the convention center. If you want to get in and out of the many Strip properties without fighting the on-Strip crowds, cars, parking, heat and other joys of in-and-out on the Strip, this is an excellent way to see lots of properties, or meet up with your friends, with little hassle. All for the price of a valet parking tip.

The monorail is electric, driverless, runs at 50 MPH, and didn't cost us local taxpayers a dime. It costs \$3 for a one-way-trip, or you can buy a pass for the price of a couple of taxi fares. Currently it has stations at the MGM, Bally's/Paris, Flamingo/Caesar's, the Las Vegas Convention Center, the venerable Las Vegas Hilton, and the Sahara. End-to-end is 14 minutes in air-conditioned comfort. Eventually, they plan to go north to the downtown and Fairmont Street areas, and south to the Airport, putting an end to some of those magical mystery tours unsuspecting visitors get on their way to their hotels.

So if you want to avoid renting a car or being held hostage to long taxi lines, consider this as a viable option for getting to and from this year's G2E, as well as visiting venues in our wonderful, never-dull town. You'll find more info online at www.lvmonorail.com.




