Are You Leaving Money on the Table?

There are lots of game family programs living on every video poker chip in the field. Over time, many develop a loyal following of players. As you know, you can enable up to 12 game families on every Game King® or multihand chip, so why not grow your poker player market? Here are a couple of games we've seen grow in popularity in Nevada and elsewhere that might just find a niche in your casino. The great thing about them both is you can have your techs enable them for free, and any new revenue is "found money" at no cost to you. You can add them to your existing game line-up, or swap out a couple of lower-performing games so your game menu doesn't overwhelm players with choices.



Triple Double Bonus Poker™

The Triple Double Bonus Poker™ game is a true gambler's game. It can be painfully volatile, but also spectacular. Aces with a kicker pay 4,000 credits like a royal. Twos, 3s and 4s with a kicker pay 2,000 credits, like aces with a kicker in the Double Double Bonus Poker® game. In reality, this is like an amped-up version of Double Double Bonus Poker® with wilder rides because these jackpots are paid for by a reduction in threeof-a-kind pays from 3 credits per coin to 2. In my experience, this

game is particularly popular with gamblers who are flush and feel like "going for it," or folks who are bored and can't quite get to that "walking money" stage. I've fallen into both categories and when in the mood, love the rush of this game, especially when you hit the big kicker combos.



Super Aces Bonus Poker™


The Super Aces Bonus Poker™ game is a gem that has also grown in popularity over the past few years. This is especially true in multi-hand games where people find rewards for dumping full houses with aces and "going for it." All 4-ace hands pay 2,000 credits, no kicker necessary. All 2s, 3s and 4s pay 400. No-kicker combos and a coin off the full house fund this one. It's an ace-lovers dream, particularly when you hold three aces and DON'T need a kicker to hit a 2,000-credit jackpot! We see tons of multi-hand play on Five Play[®] and Ten Play[™] machines, as well as Fifty and Hundred Play Draw Poker® games. Take a look and if it is there, turn it on - you'll be glad you did.





Finding the Balance between Higher Denom and Higher Coin-in

Over the past few years, we've seen many operators focusing on lower denoms accompanied by an increase in the max bet. This has certainly been the trend in video slots, and similar moves have been made in the multi-hand poker world. We've seen many folks try increasing the base wager of their Triple Play™ games from 15 credits to 30, 45 or 60, while moving the denomination down into pennies. Sometimes this has worked, sometimes not.

In the cases of the Hundred Play Draw Poker® and Fifty Play Draw Poker™ games with 500-and 250-coin max bets, respectively, the base wagers of these games were already quite high. A trend that's proving very positive for poker – and quite the opposite of video slots – is changing these game base denominations from pennies to nickels, quarters and even dollars. Even some local properties are blending this mix of low and high denom in these multi-coin, multi-hand games. And if you haven't tried your Spin Poker™ game in quarters, you're missing some incredible play.

On the Las Vegas Strip, Spin Poker[™] has generated a lot of buzz with a \$1, \$5 and even a \$10 base denom. Operators have spent years trying to find video slot games that work in these higher denominations, and Spin Poker[™] is one that really does perform well in this wagering category.

Super Times Pay Poker[™] in Triple Play[™], Five Play[®] and Ten Play[™] formats is another example of a non-penny game that is unbelievable in the local and Strip properties. A bank of Super Times Pay Poker[™] is now a common sight across casino floors. As a comparison, in some Nevada properties, we have multi-hand games set up in 25¢, 50¢, and \$1, and these games

are doing over \$30,000 per day coin-in (CI). The Super Times Pay Poker™ game, set up in \$1 denomination, is consistently in the top 10 games on the floor with daily CI of \$100,000. While the quantity of these types of games might be low, the earnings certainly aren't.

Pennies still have a place, and that's for each individual property to decide, but the trend we've seen has been toward higher denom and the more traditional 5-credit-per-hand, no matter how many hands they desire!

Red Rock Rocks!

There are many things I enjoy about being part of the gaming community here in Vegas, and casino openings are one of my favorites. In a city where everyone pushes each other and resets the bar, it's an enormous challenge to do something spectacular. Red Rock, and its opening, achieved both – in spades. And it's the Fertitta brothers' attention to detail and inspired leadership that made this event memorable.



The sense of arrival at the property is unique. The porte-cochère is expansive, with palm trees reaching through strategically located openings in the overhang. The staff is friendly and attentive. Upon entering, you're struck by the absence of casino sounds that have been replaced by piped-in music that's both welcoming and soothing. Red Rock allows you to come and go without trekking through the din of casino sounds, dear to some of us, but not always enjoyed by all. You can actually access the rooms, spa and convention center without setting foot on the casino floor. Heresy you say? Not in today's casino world. The lobby bar evolves into a quasi nightclub similar to the wildly successful boutique "W" Hotels. Kudos for this brave approach. After all, if visitors want to dine at any of the excellent restaurants, go to a movie, enjoy a martini or just explore – they'll cross the casino threshold eventually.

The casino floor itself is masterfully laid out. You have no idea that they've placed 3,200 machines in there because they've spread the myriad of entertainment options out very well, and with a heavy reliance on slant-top games, enabled a great line-of-sight that makes this enormous property seem



"manageable" as a stroller. The floor is completely wired and ready for server-based gaming's imminent arrival, and IGT's TrimLine machines' "digital glass" provides a refreshing sparkle to banks of machines we've all seen before.

The signage is unique and blends with the elements of the surrounding area – the hues of the facility – but doesn't lose the messages that inspire gamblers to stop and reach into their pockets. Instead of rotating denom signs, they've used LCD displays which work great and afford future flexibility. They've maximized the use of the pool and water by creating several outside dining and relaxing areas off of most restaurants where the gentle splash of fountains comfortably masks less-relaxing sounds.

The opening itself was highly organized, pouring excellent wines and champagnes, and the crowd was a who's who of the gaming industry, including a handful of athletes from the Ultimate Fighting Championships (a passion for the Fertittas), as well as professional gamblers and entertainers. Sting performed a surprise concert out by the pool on a beautiful, cool night. The fireworks display that followed rivaled any Fourth of July celebration I've ever seen.

I was especially impressed by the attitude of the employees. Stations had a full week of staff visiting and staying at the property with their spouses, partners or children BEFORE the opening. This was a reward to their people and resulted in comprehensive feedback on everything from television reception and towel bars to reservation efficiency. There is no substitute for pride of ownership.

The next time you visit Vegas, come and see the city's newest pride and joy – and marvel at just how high the bar sits now.





A Video Poker Family Affair

Many of us at one time or another have walked up to a video poker game, stared at the screen and thought about which game to play. Deciding what game to play can be confusing at times for some players, so it's a good idea to limit the number of game choices and verify that you have the most popular ones. Don't frustrate your players. Give them what they want and get them into the action!

Game King® video poker games have the ability to display up to 12 game families at a time on the main menu screen. Some of these are unique while some are quite similar. Generally, we believe it's a good idea to have from 5 to 7 game choices displayed.



This?

The most popular choices are typically Jacks or Better, Bonus Poker®, Bonus Poker™, Double Bonus Poker®, Double Bonus Poker®, Deuces Wild Bonus Poker®, and/or Triple Double Bonus Poker™. Although this is just an example, this particular combination does represent a time-proven mix of favorite game families. Deliberately offering fewer choices makes it easier and faster for a player to get started.

One of the pursuits Sales Product Specialists like me spend time on is helping operators maximize their win-per-unit by determining the best game families to have on a machine. This might require a bit of work the first time, but once done the operator is armed with powerful information. (This will be a snap when server-based gaming arrives!)

The steps are relatively straightforward:

- Look at the percentage of play by game family and eliminate any that are less than 2% of play
- Identify games that are popular on some machines, but not on others
- Identify a couple of experimental banks where you can enable a particular game family only on those banks, and

then check the percentage of play after 6-8 weeks to see if players like that game

- Two good game families to experiment with are Triple Double Bonus Poker[™] and Super Aces Bonus Poker[™]
- Talk to your floor staff and see if they hear grumbling or requests for games not available

Another revenue-enhancing opportunity exists with progressives. Don't just progress one game family; instead, make sure all game families with similar odds are progressed so players aren't "penalized."



Or This!

There's yet another wrinkle available if you have machines with only one game family turned on. Turn on other popular games, even if you have theme-specific game glass. Players are very familiar with multi-games, and their various superstitions drive them to move between available games when they see lots of "deuces" for example, or aces. More options mean every player can find their favorite game. By offering more choices – still within the 5-7 game range – players will not have to wait for a seat to open; they can start playing.

This exercise is just like the one performed at any retail outlet or grocery store. The store has a limited amount of space with which to promote its products and wants to provide and promote the most popular and profitable goods while making the effort of discovery and purchase easy for the consumer.

Ask questions. Join your players. They've always got an opinion, right? Video poker players are a rare breed and usually know what they want.
