Wide Area Marketing (WAM) Test Results\_

As you may know, we test each and every poker game before release so we can get a feel for how players will react to a game. We test at a variety of properties – some tourist market properties, some locals market properties, and some Native American properties. Over a six-week period, we compare the play on these games to a group of control games. The control games stay on the floor in the same position, and we change out the test games within those banks; the only games in the test banks that change are the new test games.

Once all the numbers are in, we evaluate the performance of the new games using the performance of the control games as our base. For example, if a test game performs at a 1.0 it would be performing at exactly the same level as the control games. If it performs at a .75 it would be performing 25% below the control games, and of course if a test game performs at a 1.25 it would be outperforming the control games by 25%.

The results from our latest WAM testing reveal performance numbers for Super Times Pay® Spin Poker™ and Double Pay Spin Poker™.

These two games have some similar features, but each one has its own distinctive feature. The common element here is that both games play like Spin Poker™, a 9-line video poker game. This game concept was revolutionary when it was developed and created a nice crossover between video poker and video reel slots. It features the skill and strategy satisfaction of video poker, but also has the excitement of being able to play and win on 9 lines.



Super Times Pay® Poker added to the Spin Poker™ game gives players the bonus of a possible 2 to 10 times multiplier feature. The multiplier appears approximately every 15 hands on average and creates a great deal of excitement. This game finished testing with a 1.42 rating! Obviously players love this combination.

Combining Double Pay Poker™ action with the Spin Poker™ game gives the player the advantage of being paid on the deal as well as on the draw! The deal pays are significantly higher than the draw pays because the player is being paid on a stud hand. Once the player receives the pays for the dealt hand, he or she holds the cards they want to draw to and finish the hand just like regular video poker. Wins on the drawn hand are paid according to a conventional draw poker paytable. This game completed WAM testing with a 1.47 rating – another big winner!

We expected both of these games to wow players, but even we were surprised with how well they performed. The players have voted with their wallets, and the results show they love both of these games.

### How Guaranteed Play™ Poker can grow your entire property

If you were at G2E, you already know that Guaranteed Play<sup>™</sup> Poker was one of the big hits of the show. But here's where the story gets better. Once you can sell a session of play, the way you market your entire property changes. Not only can you sell Guaranteed Play™ Poker at the machine, but you can market advance-purchase Play Tickets that are good for a guaranteed number of video poker hands. Gambling becomes a ticketed entertainment event, like the movies or a ballgame.

When you sell Play Tickets, you can then package gambling along with everything else you sell – with a buffet, with a hotel room, with a pair of show tickets. You can even create off-peak specials, using lower prices to maximize the utilization of your entire property, not just your slot floor.

In other words, Guaranteed Play™ Poker makes it possible to sell the casino experience in the same way the Walt Disney® Company sells the Walt Disney World® Resort – everything the visitor wants for one price, in one decision.

And from a player's perspective, one of the best things about Guaranteed Play™ Poker is that nothing about the game itself changes. The paytables remain the same. Each max-bet hand offers the player a shot at a full-pay 4,000-credit royal flush. But even at these attractive prices, the casino makes about the same net win from Guaranteed Play™ Poker as from selling the hands one at a time.

# Challenge Your Players with the Opponent Poker Game

Something new and really cool is coming to a casino near you. It's the Opponent Poker $^{\text{TM}}$  game – a revolutionary blend of traditional video poker, with an added element of competition against others that gives players a shot at winning big pots of coins.

Here's how it works: players pick their favorite video poker game and play using their own video poker strategy – wagering five credits on a five-card hand. In addition, they can bet another five credits (ten credits total) against two lifelike, animated opponents. When the player wins the hand, the win is based on that paytable, just like traditional video poker.

These occasional strategy switches make the game very interesting and challenging!

So ante up and watch your players revel in the fun social interaction of the Opponent Poker $^{\text{\tiny TM}}$  game.
