What Does It Take To **Crown A King?**

Finally, the King has arrived! Yes, Game King® 6.0 has the GLI approval that everyone has been waiting for - with additional jurisdictions following suit – but what does it take to upgrade your Game King[®] 4.0 or 5.0 versions to the King of all Kings? Only two major components!

If your current Game King® has the 044 processor board, you're good to go. If it's equipped with the older 039 processor board, you'll need to upgrade to the new 044 processor kit. This kit includes the 044 processor and backplane/ motherboard, providing the horsepower needed to take advantage of the features and functions offered with Game King® 6.0.

The easiest way to tell the two processors apart is as simple as examining the processor tray. The 039 tray has a bracket handle on the front of the tray; the 044 tray has a swivel handle (see photos).

The second and final part you'll need is the firmware. In California Native America, for example, where all Game King® versions rock, we're required to use GK002353 for our IGT 80960 cabinets. This firmware is burned onto an IGT memory expansion board that installs into the 044 processor. The machine glass and button panel require no change if you're converting Game King® to Game King®.

With the IGT AVP® electronics, the conversion process is even easier: you'll need separate licensed version GE0110001760010 firmware for each machine you wish to convert.

The technician will insert the licensed version firmware into the "brain box" of the game, download the program, and remove the firmware. The machine is converted – it's that simple.

There's No Playing Liar's Poker with Paytables

versus spinning reel and video slot products. Recently, it seems that hold percentages are becoming more of a focus than the overall win per unit (WPU)

for some operators, and in the poker world a tighter hold usually equates to a lower WPU. Poker players want time on device and a fair shot at winning. If you offer them this, you can build a strong video poker offering that not only produces a great win per unit, but also builds loyalty with your players.

The art of poker comes from offering your players what they want and getting the results you want - a winwin outcome. How do we determine their desires, and what is the secret to this mysterious equation? Unfortunately. there is no miracle remedy or mathematical calculation that everyone should apply across the board. Every casino, every player and every poker floor is different. You need to analyze your market and competition, and through experimentation find the fit that

When selecting paytables, it's important to note that a looser paytable doesn't mean the royal flush pays more or more frequently. What does change for the operator are the paybacks on full houses, straights and flushes. For the player, it's the time on device.

best suits your floor.

Consider the paybacks for a 95.71%, 96.79% and 98.98% Double Double Bonus Poker® game with a 5-credit bet. The top 7 pays remain the same. It isn't until the full house is drawn that any difference between the pays occurs. Walk-aways don't happen more frequently with looser paytables since the pays that change are not walk-away jackpots – just the pays that keep players

in their seats. In my own experience, when I play and I hit a straight for 20 credits, I don't walk away, but stay the course and play that money back into the game.

If you're looking for better performance out of your poker games, take a look at your paytables. Are they too tight? Experiment with those paytables. Take a bank of games and loosen them, advertise this fact and monitor the results. My guess is you won't be disappointed – and neither will your players.

Looser paytables = more time on device = higher WPU.


