High Limit Rooms are not off limits to great games

I've learned a lot representing IGT video poker products here in the Western U.S. over the past seven years. I am proud to say that we have multi-hand video poker themes in over 90% of this market which are generating truly impressive revenues for our casino partners. One area that has been much slower to develop – but is doing so very profitably – is High Limit rooms.

One of the concerns that operators have with multi-hand poker games is the jackpot liability. At first glance, this is understandable. After all, a few of our most popular multi-hand poker themes carry very high top awards, and while they are extremely rare, they will eventually hit.

For example, our Super Times Pay® has a top award of \$400,000. Ultimate X° has a \$480,000 top award, followed by Double Super Times Pay Poker™ at \$800,000. As a result, some casinos have decided these games are not an option for their high limit room. However, many are now changing their minds and dealing with the risks simply because the rewards are so exceptionally high. In fact, a large handful of properties are now giving these bad boys of poker a shot in their high limit rooms.

Our friends at Barona Resort and Casino, for example, currently offer over 20 different multi-hand poker games in their high limit room. Here, you can find Spin PokerTM, All-Star Poker[®], Hundred Play Draw Poker[®] to name just a few. To assess their appetite for risk, look no further than their offering Ten Play Ultimate X Poker[®] in a \$5 denomination!

The folks at Viejas also offer over 20 different multi-hand games, including Ultimate Four-of-a-Kind Poker, Multi Strike Poker°, and All Star° Poker. Not only does Viejas offer Super Star Poker° at the high limit bar, but they have these in AVP° uprights as well, along with great pay tables to boot!

In the Palm Desert, we have Agua Caliente, a casino property that hosts a number of different multihand games, including the stand-out winner for the last 6 years – Wheel Poker. When first cut loose, these games drove coin-in for Agua Caliente that was muy caliente!

Pala Resort Casino also has a great mix, including All-Star Poker®, Dream Card® Poker, Super Triple Play Poker and a particularly successful offering of Five Star Poker® configured as a \$1 -\$2 and -\$5. At one time I was told that these games were generating more coin-in than any other game in high limit, including slots.

I hope you're beginning to see that if you have multi-hand games on your floor but are not offering them in high limit because of the jackpot liability, there's a way to option these exceptional performers without getting crushed for the weekend.


One excellent and manageable option is to install Ultimate X Poker® but only offer it in a Triple Play format. This will limit your top award exposure to 120,000 coins, but still allow your high value players the thrill of this great game.



As 2013 comes to an end and with the Gaming Show ancient history, 2014's new revenue numbers are fast approaching for you. One question we are starting to hear over and over from operators is, "Which video poker themes do you recommend we spend our money on in the coming year?"

We're glad you asked. Because, between G2E Sales and early floor performance, IGT is in a position to provide you with information to help you maximize your spending budgets.

This year, I can easily recommend three new titles that are each excitingly unique, but nevertheless recognizable. Game play is familiar and all three are currently in the marketplace performing very well. Leading the list is Hyper Bonus Poker[®], followed by Crazy Times Pay Poker® and finally, Multi-Streak Poker®. Our confidence in these games is high because all three are built on proven, successful models – those being Super Times Pay[®], Ultimate X Poker[®] and Double Super Times Pay Poker™. These new games utilize multipliers, buy-a-pays and provide consistent entertainment without changing the underlying gambling draw that players crave.

Hyper Bonus Poker® – This is the fastest growing game since Ultimate X Poker® and is already a player-favorite. It is a 5 coinper-line, buy-a-pay where multipliers ranging from 1X to 12X are awarded to all winning hands. Each hand can qualify for different multipliers spicing up the bonus

round. The game plays a bit like Ultimate X Poker®, but multipliers are awarded on the current hand being played. This means no multipliers are left for the next "future" hands. They are all played off in present game.

Crazy Times Pay Poker® – This is also a 5 coin per-hand, buy-a-pay game. The unique bonus feature in this game is that with each hand dealt, multipliers ranging from 2X to 5X are assigned to specific and constantly changing pay categories in the pay table. Two or more multipliers are assigned to every jackpot pay category from two pair up to Royal Flush. This has the effect of introducing surprise jackpots on simple hands like three-of-a-kind or two pair and also introduces an element of strategy variation if a particular category has a high multiplier but might be more of a long shot. Crazy Times is a fun, fast-paced "gambler's game" that promises crazy returns on your floor.

Multi Streak Poker® – This is perhaps the most volatile and fun game IGT has created in years. It will appeal to everyone who likes Double Double Bonus Poker®, Triple Double Bonus Poker® and Ultimate X Poker®. Multi Streak is a 5 coin, buy-apay where players are awarded multipliers for dealt winners starting with a pair of 6's or better. If you get back-to-back dealt winners, you are now on a "streak" and you get awarded more multipliers which grow each time you have a dealt winner. But wait, there's more! Because your multipliers are awarded on future hands, not just the current one. This game has

credit swings that will make your head spin and your players lining up to get in on all the action. It's a full tilt boogie blast that we have no doubt will be a massive hit.

All three of these new, future-forward games are available for you to play right now, for free, on VideoPoker.com so you can not only see how they play, but see what on-line players think of them.

Finally, you can never go wrong with All-Star Poker II™, truly the highest earning video poker game in the industry, if not of all time. This game includes; Triple Play™, Five Play®, Ten Play™, Spin Poker®, Super Times Pay®, Ultimate X Poker® and more. Optimize your Native AVP® Video Poker for better performance.

The progression of IGT poker games to the AVP® platform has been an exciting yet challenging task. There are two versions of games that are available: 1) Emulated, GE programs and, 2) GI or native programs. The purpose of this article is to help customers install a GI program and guide them as to what NOT to do when activating the theme.

Installing a GE game is easy. When a program is emulated, it is directly duplicated from an Enhanced Game King® 80960 product. This allows everything to be installed via one flash drive and one dongle. The optioning on this machine is similar to an Enhanced Game King® 80960 product with the exception of enabling glass graphics, card sizing and "attract mode" timing. In other words, fast and familiar!

On the other hand, GI programs can require multiple flash drives and Feature Packages, referred to as "FI's", which are all in addition to the single dongle. Recently a customer called who had received All-Star Poker® II and said, "I didn't order 14 games, did I?" He hadn't, of course. It was 1 game for 1 machine with each individual game to be loaded separately. This alone can be confusing!

FI programs are usually included in conversions. Many customers don't know what these important programs do so we'll explain. The FI programs primarily enable the correct glass and tabs for the main menu. Both of these are critical elements to properly setting up a video poker machine. After all, you want to advertise the right games and attract more players, right? Because of this new, extra step, we often find AVP° video poker machines with the wrong settings which can translate into less-than-expected earnings for you, the operator.

Optimizing your AVP° Video Poker games:

When enabling the GI program, the major things to look for and to set up are:

1. If you are installing a Game King® program, make sure the digital glass, when defaulting to the Main Menu, reads "Game King®".





- 2. Adjust the timing on main menu from 15 seconds to at least 600 seconds for theme options to better promote games.
- 3. Make sure you Option up to nine games (on 8.3, this will be 12) to maximize player choices and coin-in. The default only offers four, which might not even be your player's favorite game choices. A broad selection of themes will capture a wider audience.
- 4. It is really important to disable the "more games" banner. This feature unintentionally distorts the card's shape and appearance which has an adverse effect on game play.



Disable this banner.

Make sure the FI's are installed so all tabs are enabled. For instance on Game King® 8 series, Poker, Keno, BJ and Video Reel, otherwise all the themes run together, are limited and can be confusing for players when they look for their favorite games.

Usually, the percentages and game families are the main focus when setting up your video poker machines. On these AVP® units, you need to take it a step further and ensure the presentation is just as effective, so they are as inviting and revenue-inducing as the older machines.



Keep "Moochers" off your high-earning machines

by controlling minimum bets

ould there be anything more frustrating than seeing a low denom game with high max bet capabilities being monopolized by a player betting a nickel, or worse, a penny or two at a time?

This has been a recurring complaint from operators for years and it's why IGT has strategically designed minimum bet controls on most of our games.

It's true that we have had the Minimum Acceptable Bets option for some time, but we all too often run into games that are not yet taking advantage of this feature. When this happens, there's a strong chance that higher-revenue players cannot get on a game because it's being tied up by a low-wager player.

The process to set up minimum bet controls is fast and easy and ensures that either you'll be happy with minimum-wager players or that they will move on to another machine.



Tips and Tricks

IGT makes Video Poker game set up fast and EZ!

EZ Setup allows you to store and load predetermined game sets of configuration data into your IGT video poker games. The game sets can include data for one or more game programs, as well as one or more pay tables used by a game program. This way, different set-ups by game family and denomination are all pre-loaded and configured for you on the fly-all at once, instead of one-at-a-time.

The different setup options offered cover three predefined game sets, with basic configuration items assigned for the games in the game set. Predefined game sets are classified by relative payback percentages: high, intermediate and low. Denominations are also assigned within these game sets.

As an example, we will look at different game themes within Game King® 8.2 and their predefined game sets:

By selecting one of the three choices, the machine will now be setup with its payback percentage, denomination and a range of other configurations supported by the EZ Setup tool. You can also create sliding pay tables associated with denominations of your choice in your own custom setup configuration file.

EZ Setup is currently available with Game King® 8.2, All-Star Poker® II and 3/5/10 Play. It will be implemented in all new game themes going forward.

With the ease and simplicity of EZ Setup, you'll find that multiple configurations can be managed quickly, with greater accuracy and leave you with hours to devote to other projects.
